1. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files stored on your device (computer, tablet, or smartphone) when you visit a website. They help improve your experience by remembering settings, analyzing traffic, and personalizing content.

Cookies may be **first-party** (set by **Antarctica21**) or **third-party** (set through external services such as Google, Facebook, or advertising networks).

Cookies are classified into two main types based on their lifespan:

- **Session Cookies** Temporary cookies that expire when you close your browser.
- **Persistent Cookies** Remain on your device for a set period or until manually deleted.

2. Types of Cookies We Use

We use the following categories of cookies on our Website:

2.1. Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are essential for the Website to function properly. They cannot be disabled in our systems.

Examples:

- Enabling secure login and authentication
- Protecting against security threats
- Managing website navigation

2.2. Performance & Analytics Cookies

These cookies help us understand how visitors interact with our Website by collecting anonymous usage data. We use this information to improve site performance and user experience.

Our Website uses Google Analytics for tracking visitor behavior and website traffic patterns

2.3. Functional Cookies

These cookies enhance your experience by remembering preferences such as language, region, or past actions on the site.

Examples:

- Remembering the region you are connecting from
- Saving your contact details for a smoother form submission process

2.4. Advertising & Targeting Cookies

These cookies track browsing activity to deliver relevant ads based on your interests. They may be set by third-party advertisers and social media platforms.

Examples:

- Google Ads (personalized advertising based on browsing behavior)
- Facebook Pixel (tracking engagement with our ads)

3. Third-Party Cookies

We work with trusted third parties that may place cookies on our Website. These include:

- Google Analytics To analyze traffic and improve user experience.
- Meta (Facebook & Instagram) To track ad performance and personalize content.
- YouTube To embed videos and track engagement.
